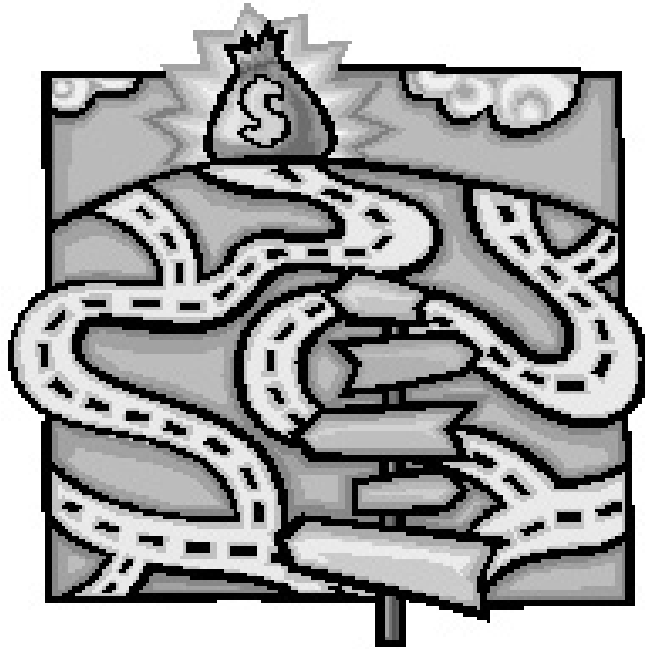

## How to Use this Directory

This directory is intended to provide a helpful initial step in the process of seeking funds. It is designed as a reference tool for Chautauqua County organizations seeking funding for programs or projects. Information cannot be guaranteed for accuracy, and the use of this guide does not assure that your grant-writing efforts will be successful.

The **Index of Funding Organizations** divides funding sources under thirteen descriptive category headings. Many funding sources are interested in supporting work in more than one category, and occasionally funding sources will offer assistance for a special project that falls outside its main areas of interest. It may be worth your time to contact a funding source either by phone, letter, or e-mail about special project considerations.

The **Alphabetical Listing of Funders** includes basic information about foundations and other major funding sources in Chautauqua County. Each page includes information about the organization's application process, the interests it traditionally supports, the availability of funds, the geographic area served, and any eligibility and limitation information that may apply. Some areas may have been left blank at the request of the funding source.

**Banks, Businesses, and Service Clubs** are listed only with basic contact information. Many of these organizations provide funding or sponsorships for smaller projects. We suggest that you contact each business or organization directly for information about how they may be able to help with your project.

Sometimes local businesses and civic groups will offer in-kind assistance – donating goods, services or volunteer time to a cause or organization. Even if they are unable to supply funding, they may provide some other resources for your project.

The **Basics of Grant Writing** page offers helpful tips about the grant-writing process. This is meant to be an overview, not a tutorial in grant writing. If you are new to grant writing, you may want to enroll in a course or grant writing workshop – offered periodically throughout the area through several organizations including Jamestown Community College, Jamestown Business College, SUNY College at Fredonia, the Arts Council, and BOCES. Local libraries also have books on grant writing that may be helpful.

A number of **Helpful Web Sites** also offer information on how to write and seek grants. Sites listed in this directory offer universal grant writing tips, regardless of the sponsoring organization. This directory also includes a short list of web sites that can provide demographic information, which may be helpful in your grant writing process. There is also a list of web sites that provide useful information about foundations.

The **Additional Regional and Governmental Directories** section provides information about funding resource directories that have a scope beyond Chautauqua County.

Organizations offering educational scholarships are not listed in this directory. A listing of such organizations can be obtained from the Chautauqua Region Community Foundation, or through local college financial aid offices and high school guidance offices.

# Basics of Grant Writing

## Before You Write

This directory is a starting point in your quest for funds. If you have identified a possible funding resource in this directory, your next step should be to gather all the information you can about that organization, and perhaps talk to others who have received funding from that source. Make contact with the funder (be sure to give yourself plenty of time before the application deadline) to make sure that your project is something they are interested in funding!

The kinds of information you should research might include:

- Priority areas of funding
- General range of giving and average grant
- Deadlines
- Required proposal information
- Length of proposal and format
- Who has received funding and for what
- What is the sponsor's primary geographic region for funding, e.g. south county only, north county only
- Eligibility requirements, e.g., not-for-profits, individuals

These are the typical components of a proposal:

**Executive Summary:** umbrella statement of your case and summary of the entire proposal

**Statement of Need:** why this project is necessary

**Project Description:** nuts and bolts of how the project will be implemented, any by whom

**Program Outcomes:** measurable results of the program

**Program Evaluation:** the anticipated outcomes and how best to measure the results

**Budget:** financial description of the project plus explanatory notes

**Future and/or Additional Funding Sources:** how the project will be sustained

**Organization Information:** history and governing structure of the nonprofit, its primary activities, audiences and services

**Appendices:** Copy of your 501(c) 3 letter, list of Board of Directors, most recent audit, etc.

## **While Creating a Proposal**

- Follow the directions put forth by the funding source, **exactly!**
- Answer all application questions in the order they are asked. The funding source has reasons for the way they want things done.
- Say enough so the sponsor can determine what you will do with the funds, how you will administer the funds, who will be responsible, when you will accomplish your proposed activities and how you will measure your accomplishments (evaluation).
- Material should be presented neatly, concisely, and completely. Proof-read carefully. Make all of the numbers add up.
- Because funding sources have a good idea of the actual cost of doing business, submit an honest, realistic budget. If you are unsure about the budget, seek help - from your organization's financial staff, volunteer treasurer, or your auditor or other knowledgeable accounting professional. Make sure you are familiar with your organization's finances before submitting a grant request.

If you need more help in grant writing, educate yourself through on-line tutorials, books, manuals and workshops in our area. If you don't have Internet access, your local library can help. Seek the advice of experienced grant writers in other organizations.

## **Follow Up to Proposal Submission**

While waiting for a decision on your application, don't hassle the funder. Your homework told you about when to expect an answer. Only after that can you call to check on the status of your proposal.

If your application is declined, seek feedback from the funder. Find out where your application fell short and where it needed improvement, in order to do a better job the next time. Also, ask if the funder would entertain a revised application for the same project.
