

## What to bring to my VITA appointment?

\*\*Click on <u>the Intake / Interview Quality Review Sheets</u> – from our website (uwayscc.org). Print, complete and bring with you along with any of the items below that are unique to you:

- 1. Government issued Photo-ID for Taxpayer (and Spouse, if applicable)
- 2. Proof of SSN or ITIN for everyone included on the return. (SS cards are best)
- 3. W-2s for all jobs worked in 2020
- 4. 1099 NEC for Non-Employee Workers (Replaces 1099 Misc for contract workers)
- 5. 1099-DIV
- 6. 1099-INT
- 7. 1099-G (This is Unemployment Compensation)-NYS does not mail these out. Taxpayers must access this on the tax.ny.gov website. Please do that before arriving at the appointment.
- 8. Receipts for cash donations.
- 9. 1099-R and RRB-1099
- 10. Form SSA-1099
- 11. Proof of other income: Gambling; Royalties; Schedule K-1
- 12. College/Post-Secondary expenses (Form 1098-T)
- 13. Student Loan Interest Statement (Form 1098-E)
- 14. Child or dependent care expenses
- 15. Expenses for eligible educator
- 16. Expenses related to self-employment income (Nothing that depreciates)
- 17. 5498-SA/1099-SA (Health Savings Account)
- 18. 1095-A (Healthcare Coverage through Marketplace)
- 19. Stimulus Payment Information (How much was received for 1st and 2nd payments)
- 20. Direct Deposit Information (Bank Routing and Account Numbers)-if applicable
- 21. For those who want to claim IT-214 (Renter's Credit): SSI payments in 2020; Cash Public assistance and relief; All other household income; Rental costs (rent and any utilities paid by renter)
